

**Caution:** Do not attempt to repair or alter the head impact energy-absorbing material glued to the headliner or to the garnish trims. If the material is damaged, replace the headliner and/or the garnish trim. Failure to do so could result in personal injury.

## **Preliminary Procedures**

- Remove the windshield. Refer to Windshield Replacement .
- Remove the instrument panel (I/P) upper trim pad. Refer to <u>Instrument Panel Upper Trim Pad Replacement</u> .
- Remove the sunshades. Refer to **Sunshade Replacement**.
- Remove the sunshade anchors. Refer to Sunshade Anchor Replacement .
- Remove the overhead console. Refer to Roof Console Replacement .
- Remove the windshield pillar garnish moldings. Refer to <u>Windshield Pillar Garnish</u> Molding Replacement .
- Remove the hinge pillar trim panels. Refer to <u>Body Hinge Pillar Trim Panel</u> Replacement.
- Remove the lock pillar trim panels. Body Lock Pillar Trim Panel Replacement .
- Remove the front assist handles. Refer to Front Assist Handle Replacement .
